Collection and Use of Personal Membership Data by Hood County Amateur Radio Club (HCARC)

All electronic club communication is sent through the Executive Board with it's recipiants listed in the Blind Carbon Copy (BCC) Field of the transmited eMail or Text. All Club eMails will contain the Prefix of, "HCARC-" followed by the subject.

HCARC encourages it's members to network and communicate with each other and asks that you share relevant contact information with each other. Unless previously granted by individual personal contact information will not be released.
